



SAN JUAN CITY COMMEMORATES 127TH PHILIPPINE INDEPENDENCE DAY AT HISTORIC PINAGLABANAN SHRINE

The City Government of San Juan commemorated the 127th Philippine Independence Day on Wednesday, June 12, 2025 at the Pinaglabanan Shrine, a site of immense historical importance in the nation's struggle for freedom.
