



SAN JUAN CITY COMMEMORATES THE 162ND BIRTH ANNIVERSARY OF ANDRES BONIFACIO WITH FLAG-RAISING AND WREATH-LAYING CEREMONY

The City Government of San Juan, in partnership with the National Historical Commission of the Philippines and various civic and community institutions, commemorated the Ika-162 Anibersaryo ng Kapanganakan ni Andres Bonifacio on Sunday, November 30, 2025, at the historic Pinaglaban Shrine.

With the theme “Isang Bayan, Isang Laban: Katapatan at Katarungan Kontra Katiwalian,” the event began with the arrival of the Guest of Honor, Mayor Francisco Javier M. Zamora, followed by the Pagtaas ng Watawat ng Pilipinas to be led by the Philippine National Police. The Himno ng Lungsod ng San Juan was rendered thereafter.

The Pag-aalay ng Bulaklak sa Bantayog ni Andres Bonifacio included floral offerings from participating groups such as the United Architects of the Philippines; Department of Education – San Juan; Pederasyon ng Sangguniang Kabataan; Liga ng mga Barangay; representatives of various city government departments; representatives of the 1st and 2nd districts of the Sangguniang Panlungsod; Vice Mayor Angelo Rafael E. Agcaoili; NHCP Deputy Executive Director Rosario V. Sapitan; and Congresswoman Ysabel Maria J. Zamora, along with the Guest of Honor and city officials.

A Gun Salute and Taps followed, honoring the legacy of the Supremo of the Katipunan.

The program concluded with the commemorative message of Mayor Francisco Javier M. Zamora, City Mayor of San Juan, President of the Metro Manila Council and National President of the League of Cities of the Philippines.
