



## **SAN JUAN CITY HOLDS ANNUAL CHRISTMAS TREE LIGHTING, FIREWORKS DISPLAY, AND OPENING OF MAKABAGONG SAN JUAN CHRISTMAS BAZAAR**

The City Government of San Juan, led by Mayor Francis Zamora, officially ushered in the holiday season with the annual Christmas Tree Lighting and Fireworks Display on December 3, 2025, at the San Juan City Hall grounds. The event also marked the opening of the Makabagong San Juan Christmas Bazaar.

Mayor Francis Zamora was joined by his wife Keri and sons Rocco, Nicolas and Noah Zamora, Congresswoman Ysabel Maria “Bel” Zamora, Vice Mayor Angelo Agcaoli, and members of the Sangguniang Panlungsod for the ceremonial lighting of the city's Christmas centerpiece—a 32-foot Christmas Tree with a 3D base accentuated with Ilokandia-inspired elements, including Inabel and Abaca Christmas balls, handmade burlap flowers, and capiz parols. The tree illuminated by 35,000 bulbs, showcased a radiant and culturally rooted holiday display.

This year's Christmas décor highlights a distinctly Filipino theme. Capiz parols further illuminated the City Hall entrance and interiors, while the exterior façade of the building will be outlined with special LED lights that follow its architectural lines, creating a festive and vibrant nighttime display.

The program featured live performances headlined by popular OPM band Sunkissed Lola, along with other guest performers, to entertain San Juaneños and visitors as they gather for the countdown to the tree lighting and fireworks show.

The Makabagong San Juan Christmas Bazaar also opened on the same evening, offering a variety of food, gift items, and local products, providing a festive marketplace for families, friends, and visitors to enjoy throughout the holiday season.
