



SAN JUAN CITY HOLDS GROUNDBREAKING FOR PHP 71-MILLION MAKABAGONG SAN JUAN CREMATORIUM AND COLUMBARIUM

The City Government of San Juan, under the leadership of Mayor Francisco Javier M. Zamora, held the groundbreaking ceremony on November 24, 2025 inside the San Juan Cemetery, for the construction of the Makabagong San Juan Crematorium and Columbarium, a modern facility designed to offer dignified, accessible, and compassionate services to San Juaneños during times of grief.

The project features four (4) chapel units on the ground floor—each equipped with its own pantry and toilet facilities—and a columbarium consisting of five (5) layers of urn niches, totaling 1,110 niches. With an approved contract budget of ₱71,000,000.00, the facility will significantly modernize and enhance the city's public cemetery services.

Importantly, the cremation services will be free for San Juan City residents, as part of the city government's continuing efforts to support families during difficult moments in their lives.

Mayor Zamora personally led the ceremony, reaffirming the Makabagong San Juan Administration's commitment to expanding city facilities and delivering compassionate, efficient, and people-centered public service for all.
