



SAN JUAN CITY OFFERS FREE SPAY AND NEUTER SERVICES FOR PETS

The City Government of San Juan, through the City Veterinary Office, provided free spay and neuter services along with other veterinary care for pet on February 13, 2025 at the Barangay Batis Multipurpose Hall.

Dubbed "Furry Valentine: Date with Your Pets," this initiative aims to support up to 300 cats and dogs in San Juan City, promoting responsible pet ownership while helping control the population of stray animals.

"This initiative is our way of protecting pets and supporting their owners. Spay and neuter services are costly in private veterinary clinics, so we hope this program helps ease the financial burden of pet care. We also want to use this opportunity to raise awareness about animal welfare in our community," said Mayor Francis Zamora.

In addition to spay and neuter procedures, pet owners can also avail of free veterinary services, including:

- ✓ Consultation
- ✓ Anti-rabies vaccinations
- ✓ Microchipping
- ✓ Deworming for small-breed puppies and kittens

As an early Valentine's treat for pets and pet owners, the city has also launched the "Furry Valentine: Date with Your Pets" Photo Contest. The top five (5) entries with the most heart and like reactions were announced on the same day, with winners receiving their awards during the flag-raising ceremony on February 17, 2025.
