



SAN JUAN INAUGURATES MAKABAGONG NATIONAL GOVERNMENT CENTER

The City Government of San Juan will officially inaugurate and bless the Makabagong San Juan National Government Center (NGC) on August 7, 2025 at 8:00 AM, beginning with a short program at the Makabagong San Juan Theater located on the 4th floor.

Leading the ceremony are Mayor Francis Zamora, Congresswoman Bel Zamora, Vice Mayor Angelo Agcaoili, members of the San Juan City Council, and City Department Heads.

After the program, the blessing and unveiling of markers will take place throughout the building, starting with the theater marker unveiling at the 4th floor, followed by the blessing of the upper floors, then moving down to the lower levels. A special marker unveiling at the Ground Floor and the blessing of the District Office of Congresswoman Zamora on the 3rd floor will also be held.

The Makabagong San Juan National Government Center is a modern, six-story facility with a lower ground floor and basement parking. Designed to centralize access to national government services for San Juaneños, the NGC is currently home to the Bagong Pilipinas eGovPH Serbisyo Hub, and will soon welcome other national agencies.

One of the building's centerpiece features is the Makabagong San Juan Theater, a state-of-the-art performance venue with a total seating capacity of 876 — comprising 468 seats on the lower level and 408 seats on the balcony. The theater is equipped with retractable curtains, a projector screen and projector, a built-in professional sound system, and two dressing rooms — offering an ideal space to showcase the talent and creativity of San Juaneños.

From the 1st to the 3rd floor, the NGC houses 15 office units per floor designated for national government offices and allied services. The building also includes a dedicated space for the Barangay Hall of St. Joseph and features a wooden-covered basketball court with air conditioning, providing an indoor venue for sports and community events.

"This National Government Center is a testament to our commitment to bring national services closer to our constituents. San Juaneños no longer need to travel far to access agencies and services that should be within reach. This center is for the people of San Juan—accessible, functional, and Makabago," said Mayor Francis Zamora.
