



TURNOVER OF FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE PROVINCE OF CEBU AND THE CITY OF BOGO

San Juan City Mayor Francis Zamora personally turned over a total of ₱2 million in financial assistance to the Province of Cebu and the City of Boggo to support ongoing relief and rehabilitation efforts following the magnitude 6.9 earthquake that recently struck the province.

The financial aid—₱1 million each for the Province of Cebu and the City of Boggo—was sourced from the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund (LDRRMF) of San Juan City under City Ordinance No. 32, Series of 2025.

As President of the League of Cities of the Philippines (LCP), Mayor Zamora also turned over an additional ₱1 million check from the LCP to Boggo City.

The ₱2 million aid from the City of San Juan, authorized through City Ordinance No. 32, Series of 2025, aims to assist in the recovery and rebuilding of communities affected by the recent earthquake in Cebu. The initiative highlights San Juan City's commitment to inter-LGU cooperation and compassion in times of disaster.
